For what purposes your personal data will be processed and what is the legal basis for processing of your personal data will be processed?

If you decide to order the newsletter of the SDPI, your personal data will be processed *for the purposes of sending newsletters*.

Please be notified that processing of your personal data for the purposes of sending newsletters will be carried out *on the basis of your consent* (Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR). In other words, you *are not obliged to order our newsletter*; however, if you wish to order it, you must provide your personal data because otherwise the SDPI cannot send the newsletter to you.

Your *consent will be valid for 5 years* unless you withdraw it earlier.

What your personal data is processed?

Please be notified that if you order a newsletter of the SDPI, the **following personal data concerning you** will be processed at the SDPI:

Identification data	e-mail address
Data related to the confirmation of the consent to receive the newsletter of the SDPI and its validity	fact, date and time of confirmation; fact, date and time of cancellation of the consent
Other personal data	correspondence (<i>where a natural person can be identified from such correspondence</i>)

To whom your personal data will be provided?

In case you subscribed SDPI's newsletters, your personal data will be provided to Information Society Development Committee (data processor providing the Inspectorate with the maintenance of lrv.lt portal on which the SDPI website is located). It is not planned to provide personal data to other third parties including third parties in third countries.

Only in the cases set out in legal acts and where provision of personal data is necessary and proportionate for legitimate and specific purposes, your personal data may be transferred to *courts*.

How long your personal data will be stored?

If you order the newsletter, the SDPI will store your personal data for the period of validity of the consent and, for the purposes of ensuring the archiving requirements, for 2 years from the expiry of the period of validity of the consent.

What are your rights and how you exercise them?

You as a data subject have the following rights:

1. Right to access information on data processing (Articles 13 and 14 of GDPR)
2. Right of access data (Article 15 of GDPR)
3. Right to rectification (Article 16 of GDPR)
4. Right to erasure (right to be forgotten) (Article 17 of GDPR). Note: this right may be exercised when at least one of the conditions set out in Article 17(1) GDPR is met.
5. Right to restriction of processing (Article 18 of GDPR). Note: this right may be exercised when at least one of the conditions set out in Article 18(1) GDPR is met;
6. Right to data portability (Article 20 of GDPR). Note: this right can be exercised when personal data are processed on the basis of consent and by automated means.
7. **Right not to give consent or cancel it at any time** (Article 21(3) of GDPR).

Please be notified that you can ***withdraw your consent*** to newsletters ***in the following ways***:

1. By pressing "Newsletter unsubscribe" in the newsletter received;
2. by contacting the SDPI from the email that you registered for sending newsletter.

Please be notified that if you object to the decision on your request concerning exercise of your rights as the data subject's rights taken by the SDPI, you are entitled to lodge a complaint to Vilnius Regional Administrative Court.
