For what purposes your personal data will be processed and what is the legal basis for the processing of your personal data?

If you decide to address the SDPI with a notification of personal data breach (hereinafter referred to as the “PDB”), your personal data will be processed *for the purposes of carrying out of inspections (preventive inspections, inspections of the EU information systems (Schengen Information System, Customs Information System, Visa Information System, Eurodac), notifications of PDB etc.) and audits.*

In case the obligation to cooperation with other data protection supervisory authorities of the Member States of the European Union and the European Economic Area arises in the course of examination of notifications concerning PDB and, where appropriate, in course of carrying out of inspections or audits in relation to such notifications, for example, when the PDB is related to processing of personal data in several countries, your personal data would also be processed *for the purposes of ensuring international cooperation including implementation of consistency.*

Note: In cases where your personal data are processed for the purpose of *international cooperation, including consistency*, other data protection supervisory authorities operating in the European Economic Area act as joint controllers with the SDPI (list is available here: https://edpb.europa.eu/about-edpb/about-edpb/members_en) and in the case of consistency procedure (Article 63 of GDPR), the European Data Protection Board is also the joint controller (see its privacy notice here: https://edpb.europa.eu/about-edpb/legal-notice/data-protection-notice_en).

Please be notified that processing of personal data for the afore-mentioned purposes is carried out in compliance with the legal obligation (Article 6(1)(c) of the General Data Protection Regulation) which shall be set forth in:

1. Article 33, Article 57(1)(h) and, where applicable, Article 56(1), Article 57(1)(g), Articles 60–62 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on

- the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation);
2. Article 26, Article 40(1)(10) and, where applicable, Article 40(1)(9) of the Republic of Lithuania Law on Legal Protection of Personal Data, Processed for the Purposes of Prevention, Investigation, Detection or Prosecution of Criminal Offences, or the Execution of Criminal Penalties, or National Security, or Defence;
 3. Article 11(1), and, where applicable, Article 11(2)(3), Article 12(2)(6) of the Republic of Lithuania Law on Legal Protection of Personal Data.

What your personal data is processed?

Please be notified that if you address the SDPI with a notification of PDB, the **following personal data concerning you** will be processed:

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Please be notified that the **SDPI will receive** your personal data:

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| directly from you | representative of the public authority, organisation, entity in which you work or which processes your personal data (for example, where the notice is given on your behalf etc.) |
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To whom your personal data will be provided?

To the Information Society Development Committee (*if the notification is lodged through e-services, i.e. E-Government Gateway*)

To the data processors providing the Inspectorate with the maintenance of information systems (including document management systems) and other related services

To public authority competent to examine the notification (*for example, where the PDB is related to a cyber incident, criminal activity etc.*)

To the public authorities, data controllers or other persons of Lithuania and, where necessary, the European Union or third countries (*for example, where the PDB is related to them*)

To the courts for examination of the actions (omission of action) of the SDPI

To other data controllers, for example, law enforcement authorities, to the National Audit Office etc. (*in the cases set out in the legal acts and where provision of personal data is necessary and proportionate for legitimate and specific purposes*)

How long your personal data will be stored?

Your personal data will be stored for the period of examination of notifications of PDB and, where applicable, during the period of inspections and also the following periods for the purposes of ensuring the archiving requirements:

What are your rights and how you exercise them?

You as a data subject are entitled to address the SDPI for any issues related to processing of your personal data, i.e. you have the following rights:

1. Right to access information on data processing (Article 13 and 14 of GDPR)
2. Right of access data (Article 15 of GDPR)
3. Right to rectification (Article 16 of GDPR)
4. Right to erasure (right to be forgotten) (Article 17 of GDPR). Note: this right may be exercised when at least one of the conditions set out in Article 17(1) GDPR is met.
5. Right to restriction of processing (Article 18 of GDPR). Note: this right may be exercised when at least one of the conditions set out in Article 18(1) GDPR is met.

Please be notified that if you object to the decision on your request concerning exercise of your rights as the data subject's rights taken by the SDPI, you are entitled to lodge a complaint to Vilnius Regional Administrative Court.
