For what purposes your personal data will be processed and what is the legal basis for processing of your personal data?

If you provide notifications of the appointed data protection officers (hereinafter referred to as the “DPOs”) or if you are a DPO in relation to whom the notification is provided, your personal data will be processed *for the purposes of administration of notices of the data protection officers appointed by data controllers and data processors.*

Please be notified that processing of personal data for the afore-mentioned purposes is carried out in compliance with the legal obligation (Article 6(1)(c) of the General Data Protection Regulation) which shall be set forth in:

1. Article 37(7) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation);
2. Article 31(4) of the Republic of Lithuania Law on Legal Protection of Personal Data, Processed for the Purposes of Prevention, Investigation, Detection or Prosecution of Criminal Offences, or the Execution of Criminal Penalties, or National Security, or Defence.

What your personal data is processed?

Please be notified that the **SDPI will receive** your personal data:

- directly from you;
- from the data controllers (data processors) that appointed you or their representatives.

To whom your personal data will be provided?

To the Information Society Development Committee (*if the notice is submitted through e-services, i.e. E-Government Gateway*)

To the data processors providing the Inspectorate with the maintenance of information systems (including document management systems) and other related services

To courts (*for examination of disputes concerning actions (omission of action) of the SDPI*)

To other data controllers, for example, law enforcement authorities, to the National Audit Office etc. (*in the cases set out in the legal acts and where provision of personal data is necessary and proportionate for legitimate and specific purposes*)

Provision of personal data to third countries is not planned.

How long your personal data will be stored?

Personal data of the DPO or the data controller (data processor) that appointed him/her where he/she is a natural person will be stored as long as information that DPO has ceased to hold the position of the DPO is provided to the SDPI.

Also your personal data will be stored for the purposes of ensuring the archiving requirements as follows:

Notification of the appointed data protection officer	5 years
Records in the list of appointed DPOs	5 years (<i>from the date on which the DPO ceases to hold the position</i>)

What are your rights and how you exercise them?

You as a data subject are entitled to address the SDPI for any issues related to processing of your personal data, i.e. you have the following rights:

1. Right to access information on data processing (Article 13 and 14 of GDPR)
2. Right of access data (Article 15 of GDPR)
3. Right to rectification (Article 16 of GDPR)
4. Right to erasure (right to be forgotten) (Article 17 of GDPR). Note: this right may be exercised when at least one of the conditions set out in Article 17(1) GDPR is met.
5. Right to restriction of processing (Article 18 of GDPR). Note: this right may be exercised when at least one of the conditions set out in Article 18(1) GDPR is met.

Please be notified that if you object to the decision on your request concerning exercise of your rights as the data subject's rights taken by the SDPI, you are entitled to lodge a complaint to Vilnius Regional Administrative Court.
